4/8/2015 11:00 PM Officer responded to a report of an assault at the 200 block of Race Street. A 21 year old Ames man was struck by a 24 year old Waukee woman who fled the scene. Several attempts to contact the suspect were made and ignored. A warrant was requested for Serious Assault with the County Attorney's Office.

4/23/2015 8:52 AM Officer responded to the 200 block of 5<sup>th</sup> Street for an unattended death. No foul play was suspected after investigating the scene. The Medical Examiner was called and came to the scene and was able to determine the death to be of natural causes.

4/24/2015 11:29 AM Officer took a theft report at the 700 block of Race Street. A 19 year old Witchita, KS woman had taken money from her grandmother while visiting her home in Cambridge. Most of the money was recovered after the victim had realized it was missing and confronted her granddaughter and friends. A call was placed to the suspect to set up an interview and the investigation is ongoing.

Huxley officers had three arrests for the month stemming from investigating an incident that took place earlier in the year. Officers issued four citations for traffic offenses and gave eight warnings. Officers received 39 calls for service and had a total of 82 contacts for the month. Officers had 15 hours toward investigations, answering calls, or providing assistance and gave 95.75 hours of general patrol.
