8/3/2015 11:00 AM Officer took a Criminal Mischief call at the 100 block of Water Street. A lock used to secure a 5th wheel trailer had been cut some time in the past few days. No property was taken and no damage to the trailer was apparent.

8/12/2015 8:27 PM Officer stopped a vehicle at 4th and Park for a traffic violation. The driver of the vehicle, a 33 year old Ames man, was arrested for Possession of a controlled Substance (Heroin), Possession of Paraphernalia, and also an active warrant for his arrest. He was transported to the Story County Jail in Nevada.

8/14/2015 2:27 PM Officer stopped a vehicle for a traffic violation on 580th and 310th. The driver of the vehicle, a 49 year old Ames man, was suspended from driving. He was cited and released with a court date for Driving Under Suspension.

8/28/2015 6:35 AM Officer took a theft report at the 100 block of 6th Street. Two vehicles parked in the driveway had items taken from them during the overnight hours. The two vehicles were left unlocked so no forced entry to cause any damage. Items taken include a wallet with cash and credit cards, a back pack with credit cards and tax information, and three flashlights.

8/31/2015 8:50 AM Officer stopped a vehicle for a traffic violation on 4th near Ballard East Elementary. The driver of the vehicle, a 33 year old Des Moines man, was suspended from driving. He was cited and released with a court date for Driving Under Suspension.

Huxley officers had five arrests for the month. Two were for Driving Under Suspension, one for Possession of a Controlled Substance, one for Possession of Paraphernalia, and one warrant served. Officers issued eight citations for traffic violations and gave twenty warnings. Officers received 14 calls for service and had a total of 71 contacts for the month. Officers had 2.75 hours of investigations, answering calls, or providing service and gave 79.75 hours of general patrol.
