Monthly Report

10/2/2015 4:43 PM Officer took a Fraud report from a Cambridge man. Approximately \$450 in purchases were made online that were not made by the owner of the credit card that was used to make the purchases. Charges to the card were reversed. Investigation ongoing.

10/2/2015 5:30 PM Officer received a theft report at the 200 block of 4<sup>th</sup> Street. A Cambridge man had approximately \$700 in change taken from his home that he had kept in a coffee can. No signs of forced entry to the home were found. No suspects at this time.

10/9/2015 5:15 PM Officer stopped a vehicle of 580<sup>th</sup> near the south city limits for a traffic violation. The driver of the vehicle, a 45 year old Cambridge man, was suspended from driving and also had a state wide warrant for his arrest. The man was arrested for Driving While License Suspended and the Warrant was served. He was transported to the Story County Jail in Nevada.

10/16/2015 2:40 PM Officer observed a known suspended driver operating a vehicle at the intersection of Center and Water Street. An arrest warrant was made for the violation.

10/27/2015 10:30 AM Officer served an arrest warrant for both Story and Cerrro Gordo County. A 45 year old Cambridge man was transported to the Story County Jail in Nevada.

Huxley Officers had four arrests for the month. Three were for arrest warrants and one was for Driving While License Suspended. Officers issued seven citations for traffic violations and gave sixteen warnings. Officers received 23 calls for service or assistance and had a total of 71 contacts for the month. Officers used 14 hours for investigations, answering calls, or providing assistance and gave 61.5 hours of general patrol.
