2/2/2015 8:25 AM Officer responded to a three vehicle accident at the intersection of E 1st and Highway 69. A vehicle operated by a 64 year old Huxley man ran a red light at the intersection causing a collision with two other vehicles. There were no injuries and approximately \$16,500 in damage to the vehicles involved.
