3/3/2015 8:21 AM Officer took a missing person report at the 300 block of N 2<sup>nd</sup> Ave. A 32 year old Huxley woman was not at home and her three juvenile children were unable to get a hold of her. The woman was located and it was found out she was in Des Moines all night. All three children were taken to school by HPD. DHS was notified of the incident.

3/3/2015 3:37 PM Officer stopped a vehicle at the south Main extension. The driver of the vehicle, a Huxley juvenile, was referred into Juvenile Court for Possession of Drug Paraphernalia and released to his parents.

3/4/2015 3:00 PM Officer stopped a vehicle at the 100 block of Main. The driver of the vehicle, a 46 year old Huxley man, was revoked from driving. He was arrested for Driving While Revoked and transported to the Story County Jail in Nevada.

3/26/2015 3:00 PM Officer took a criminal mischief complaint at the 100 block of N 5<sup>th</sup> Ave. A mailbox had been struck costing approximately \$40 to replace.

3/26/2015 7:20 PM Officer responded to the 100 block of National Dr. for an altercation between son and mother. A 15 year old juvenile was referred into juvenile court for assault and transported to Rosedale in Ames.

3/29/2015 11:30 AM Officer took a criminal mischief complaint at the 400 block of Centennial. A mailbox had been struck with a blunt object but remained intact.

Huxley Officers had 9 arrests for the month. Two were for OWI, one for Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, one for Driving While Revoked, one for Domestic Assault, one for Interference with Official Acts, one for Driving Under Suspension, one for Assault, and one warrant served. Officers issued 25 citations for traffic offenses and gave 84 warnings. Officers received 180 calls for service or information and had a total of 425 contacts for the month. Officers had 262.25 hours of investigations, providing service, or answering questions and had 469.25 hours of general patrol.
