Monthly Report

6/1/2015 5:15 AM Officer responded to a car vs. deer accident on 320<sup>th</sup> between Huxley and Slater. A vehicle operated by a Slater man struck a deer causing approximately \$1500 in damage. No injuries

6/4/2015 12:01 PM Officer responded to a report of Criminal Mischief at the 500 block of E 1<sup>st</sup>. A storage unit had been damaged with an estimated \$250 for repair.

6/5/2015 8:53 PM Officer stopped a vehicle for a traffic violation on Highway 210 near 560<sup>th</sup>. The driver of the vehicle, a 24 year old Ankeny man, was suspended from driving. He was cited and released with a court date for Driving Under Suspension.

Huxley Officers had six arrests for the month. One was for Driving While Barred, one for Public Intoxication, one for Carrying Weapons Under the Influence, one for Driving Under Suspension, one for Operating While Intoxicated, and one warrant served. Officers issued 22 citations and gave 70 warnings. Officers received 156 calls for service or information had had a total of 417 contacts for the month. Officers had 255 hours toward investigations, providing assistance, or answering calls and gave 454.75 hours of general patrol.
