Monthly Report

11/1/2015 2:50 AM Officer responded to a car vs deer accident on Interstate 35 near the 105 Mile Marker northbound. A vehicle operated by an Ames man struck a deer causing approximately \$4000 in damage. No injuries.

11/2/2015 9:47 AM Officer took a theft report at the 300 block of 3rd Street. Approximately \$150 worth of ice fishing equipment was taken from a garage. It had been several months since the owner had used the equipment so it is unknown when these items were taken.

11/2/2015 9:05 PM Officer responded to a two vehicle accident at the Ballard Middle School parking lot. A vehicle operated by a Ballard student and another operated by a Huxley man were involved in the accident while leaving a football game causing approximately \$1100 in total damage. No injuries.

11/5/2015 7:28 AM Officer cited a 59 year old Slater woman for a stop arm violation at the 100 block of Oak Blvd.

Huxley Officers had three arrests for the month. One was for Driving While License Suspended, one for Possession of a Controlled Substance, and one warrant served. Officers issued 21 citations for traffic violations and gave 43 warnings. Officers received 127 calls for service or information and had a total of 308 contacts for the month. Officers used 234.75 hours for investigations, answering calls, or providing service and gave 439.5 hours of general patrol.
