Monthly Report

2/1/2016 12:00 PM Officer took a Stolen Credit Cards report at a business at the 700 block of Highway 69. Two unknown females used a stolen credit card to make purchases at the business. Surveillance video was gathered from the business and the case remains under investigation.

2/3/2016 10:33 AM Officer responded to a single vehicle accident at the intersection of Meadow Lane and Park Ridge. A vehicle operated by a Huxley man slid into a stop sign causing minimal damage to his vehicle and the sign.

2/11/2016 4:53 PM Officer responded to a domestic altercation at the 200 block of Centennial between a mother and her two sons. The officer assisted with calming the situation until the family could cohabitate without any further altercations.

2/12/2016 9:35 AM Officer issued a school bus stop arm citation to a Huxley woman for a violation that occurred at the 1000 block of Timberlane.

2/12/2016 3:30 PM Officer issued a school bus stop arm citation to a Kelley man for a violation that occurred on Highway 69.

2/21/2016 8:45 PM Officer responded to the 100 block of Oak Blvd for a report of Criminal Mischief. A vehicle owned by a Huxley woman had all four tires deflated while the vehicle was in the parking lot. No damage to the tires aside from the air being let out.

Huxley Officers had four arrests for the month. One was for OWI, and another for a warrant. Two other arrests were made as the result of the investigation of a theft call made in January of this year. Huxley Officers issued thirteen citations for traffic violations and gave fifty six warnings. Officers received 137 calls for service, assistance, or information and had a total of 332 contacts for the month. Officers used 257 hours toward investigations, providing assistance, or service and gave 399.75 hours of general patrol.
