How the program works:

1. Any child from birth to before entering Kindergarten can participate in the program.
2. Register with Cathy at the library.
3. Bring in your log after completing each set of 100 books. The library will keep track of your logs and each 100 books earns a small prize.
4. When you reach 1000 books, the child will receive a certificate and be invited to a 1001 party! Parties will be held each February and August.

Why register?

Your home is where your child begins to learn. Developing literacy skills begins at birth and continues during the school years. The best way to insure necessary skills for reading is having someone read aloud.

Can it be done?

1 story every day for 5 years
= 1825 stories!

1 story every day for 4 years
= 1460 stories!

1 story every day for 3 years
= 1095 stories!

10 stories every week for 2
years = 1040 stories!

20 stories every week for 1
year = 1020 stories!
