6/2/2017 5:06 PM Officer responded to a domestic altercation at the 300 block of Main Ave. The altercation was verbal and both parties agreed to remain separated for the remainder of the night.

Officers received 153 calls for service or information and had a total of 399 contacts for the month. Officers used 231.75 hours for investigations, responding to calls, or providing service and gave 431.5 hours of general patrol.
