- Reduce the effects of summer sun
- Reduce winter wind
- Can reduce energy usage by 30% decreasing your utility bill

Energy Saving Locations

- Plant shade trees on the east, southeast, west or southwest sides of your home
- Plant Evergreen trees on the north or northwest sides of homes

Planting Distances

- Plant at the distance at least one half the size of the mature tree spread.
- Example: A tree with a 50' spread should be planted 25' from the house.

Stunning fall leaf colors accent the smooth greenish white to cream-colored bark on a long and narrow trunk.

Height: 40' - 70'

Spread: 40' - 60'

Shape: Oval



Northern Pecan

nut producer, provides great shade, and sports an amazing grain.

Height: 70' - 100'

Spread: 40'-75'

Shape: Oval



Service Berry

This tree is an all-season beauty. Early in the spring, beautiful white clusters of blooms set it off against the new green of spring. Vivid red- and gold-hued foliage graces the landscape in the fall. And plump red berries are a favorite of birds in summer.

Height: 15' - 25'

Spread: 15' - 25'

Shape: Rounded



Red Oak

Bristle-tipped leaves turn red in the fall.

Height: 60' - 75'

Spread: 45'

Shape: Rounded



London Planetree

Fast growing, resistant to anthracnose. Prefers moist, well-drained soil and full sun to light shade.

Height: 75'-100'

Spread: 80'

Shape: Pyramidal

American Elm

Graceful, stately shape, with branches like spreading fountains, and their green leaves that turn gold in fall.

Height: 40' - 60'

Spread: 20' - 40'

Shape: Vase



Ginkgo

Unique, fan-shaped leaves turn a stunning yellow color in the fall.

Height: 25' - 50'

Spread: 25' - 35'

Shape: Rounded



Honey Locust

Shapely crown with sturdy trunk & open branching habit.

Height: 40'-50'

Spread: 30'-35'

Shape: Oval



Norway Spruce

Features dark green needles that are roughly 1/2-1" in length.

Height: 40' - 60'

Spread: 25' - 30'

Shape: Pyramidal
