12/6/2017 1:15 PM Officer stopped a vehicle for a traffic violation on E 4<sup>th</sup> near Ballard East. The driver of the vehicle, a 47 year old Addison, IL man, was suspended from driving. He was cited and released with a court date for Driving Under Suspension.

12/11/2017 8:47 AM Officer was asked to check the welfare of a citizen at the 200 block of Vine. Contact was made with a 20 year old who was transported to the hospital for treatment.

12/16/2017 1:35 AM Officer responded to a medical emergency at the 600 block of 4<sup>th</sup> Street. Contact was made with a Cambridge resident who agreed to transport to the hospital for treatment.

12/16/2017 3:37 PM Officer stopped a vehicle for a traffic violation on 4<sup>th</sup> Street near Park. The driver of the vehicle, an 18 year old Ames man, was arrested for Possession of Paraphernalia. A juvenile in the passenger seat was referred into Juvenile Court for the same and released to a parent.

Huxley Officers had two arrests for the month. One was for Driving Under Suspension, and the other for Possession of Paraphernalia. Officers issued ten citations for traffic violations and gave thirty two warnings. Officers received eighteen calls for service or information and had a total of eighty six contacts for the month. Officers used fours toward investigations or answering calls for service and gave 73.25 hours of general patrol.
