12/5/2017 10:17 AM Officer took a burglary complaint at the 1500 block of Blue Sky Blvd. A construction trailer had been entered. No property taken from within.

12/6/2017 10:42 AM Officer responded to the High School parking lot for a vehicle accident. A parked vehicle owned by a Madrid student was struck by a vehicle operated by a student from Huxley causing minimal damage.

Officers issued nineteen citations for traffic violations and gave 114 warnings. Officers received 110 calls for service and had a total of 393 contacts for the month. Officers used 230.25 hours toward investigations or answering calls for service and gave 461.75 hours of general patrol.
