4/1/2018 5:59 PM Officer responded to a single vehicle accident at the 400 block of North 2nd Ave. A vehicle operated by an Ames woman struck a mail box causing minor damage to the vehicle. Mail box owner was notified.

Officers used 272 hours toward investigations or providing service and gave 452 hours of general patrol.
