5/28/2018 10:21 PM Officer responded to a domestic altercation at the 600 block of 1st Street. A 40 year old Cambridge man was arrested for Domestic Assault and Obstruction of Emergency Communications. He was transported to the Story County Jail in Nevada.

5/30/2018 9:18 PM Officer responded to a theft report at the 400 block of Pearl Street. Two orange wheel chocks were taken off of a work truck valued at \$72.50.

Huxley Officers had five arrests for the month. One was for Eluding, another for Interference, one for Driving Under Suspension, one for Domestic Assault, and one for Obstruction of Emergency Communications. Officers issued two citations for traffic offenses and gave nine warnings. Officers had eighteen calls for service and had a total of sixty two contacts for the month. Officers used 26 hours toward investigations or answering calls for service and gave 86.5 hours of general patrol.
