August 7th, 2018 1:30 PM Officer responded to a complaint of a check written from a closed account at a business at the 100 block of Highway 69. Under investigation.

August 7th, 2018 8:14 PM Officers were asked to assist Story County Deputies in Kelley at the 600 block of Giddings Street. A 44 year old Belle Plaine, IA man was arrested for Public Intoxication, Interference with official acts, Possession of a Controlled Substance, and Possession of drug paraphernalia. He was transported to the Story county Jail in Nevada.

August 8th, 2018 1:59 AM Officers responded to a burglary at the 200 block of Oak Blvd. A Huxley woman and a Ft. Dodge woman entered an apartment and attempted to take items from within and were interrupted by the tenant. The Huxley woman was identified and taken to Story County Jail in Nevada for Burglary 3rd and Theft 5th. Warrants for the arrest of the Ft. Dodge woman were filed for the same charges.

August 14th, 2018 11:00 AM Officer received a theft complaint at the 400 block of Bella Vista Court. Construction items valued at \$1000 were taken from the site.

August 18th, 6:00 PM Officer responded to a domestic altercation at the 100 block of Oak Blvd. A 39 year old Huxley man was arrested for Aggravated Domestic Assault, and Interference with Official Acts. He was transported to the Story County Jail in Nevada.

August 19th, 2018 5:41 PM Officer responded to a domestic altercation at the 500 block of E 1st Street. The altercation was verbal and both parties remained separated for the night.

August 21st, 2018 12:15 PM Officer received a fraud report from Casey's. Two suspects have been involved in ongoing fraud involving Visa cards and Lottery tickets throughout Minnesota and Iowa. Information was gathered and shared with Casey's corporate.

August 25th, 2018 1:04 AM Officer arrested a 21 year old Slater man after he was involved in a physical altercation at the Huxley Prairie Festival beer tent. He was charged with Disorderly Conduct and transported to the Story County Jail.

August 25th, 2018 1:30 PM Officer responded to a two vehicle accident on Highway 69 near E 4th Street. A vehicle operated by a Huxley woman was struck from behind by a vehicle operated by a rural Alleman man. No injuries.

August 26th, 2018 6:56 AM Officer received a harassment complaint at the 100 block of National Drive. Contact was made with a 34 year old Huxley man who agreed to stop the behavior in order to avoid future police attention.

August 26th, 2018 10:36 PM Officer responded to an assault at a business on E 4th and Highway 69. A 33 year old Huxley man was arrested for two Assaults and False Imprisonment. He was transported to the Story County Jail.

August 30th, 2018 6:15 PM Officer received a theft complaint at Monsanto. A trailer valued at \$7000 was taken from the property. Security footage is being examined and the case is still under investigation.

Huxley Officers had seven arrests for the month. Charges include Burglary, Theft, Domestic Assault, Interference with Official Acts, Disorderly Conduct, Assault, and False Imprisonment. Huxley Officers issued fifteen citations for traffic offenses and gave fifty four warnings. Officers received 178 calls for service and had a total of 398 contacts for the month. Officers used 293.25 hours toward investigations or answering calls for service and gave 557.75 hours of general patrol.

One officer was sent to a training on active shooter scene command during the month.

Two officers also presented ALICE (active shooter) training to Monsanto staff.

One officer taught ALICE to student at East Elementary this month.
