August 14th, 2018 8:19 PM Officer stopped a vehicle for a traffic violation on 4th near the West City limits. The driver of the vehicle, a 19 year old Cambridge woman, was suspended from driving. She was cited and released for Driving Under Suspension.

August 22nd, 2018 12:25 AM Officer stopped a vehicle for a traffic violation on Highway 210 near 570th. The driver of the vehicle, a 20 year old Des Moines man, was arrested for an .02 violation.
