Monthly Report for the City of Huxley
January 2019

January 1st, 2019 2:24 AM Officer stopped a vehicle for a traffic violation on Highway 69 near National Drive. The driver of the vehicle, a 19 year old Altoona woman, was arrested for OWI. She was transported to the Story County Jail in Nevada.

January 4th, 2019 8:45 PM Officer responded to a hit and run accident on Interstate 35 on the northbound off ramp to Highway 210. A Huxley man was sideswiped by an unknown vehicle while stopped at the stop sign. The suspect vehicle then left Westbound on Highway 210. No description of the suspect vehicle was made available.

Officers received 105 calls for service during the month and had a total of 340 contacts. Officers used 296.5 hours toward investigations or handling calls and gave 490.25 hours of general patrol.
