Monthly Report and Activities for November of 2018

November 6th, 2018 1:45 PM Officer served an arrest warrant at the 300 block of Sycamore Blvd. A Huxley man was transported to the Story County Jail in Nevada.

November 7th, 2018 11:10 PM Officer responded to a domestic altercation at the 300 block of Larson. The altercation was verbal, and the male half elected to stay in Ames for the remainder of the night.

November 8th, 2018 7:32 AM Officer responded to a two vehicle accident at the Ballard Middle School. A vehicle operated by a Huxley woman was struck by another Huxley woman while pulling forward from a parking position causing approximately \$2500 in damage.

November 12th, 2018 5:07 PM Officer responded to a car vs deer accident on Highway 69 near 310th. A vehicle operated by an Ankeny woman struck a deer causing approximately \$2000 in damage to her vehicle.

The suspect, a 28 year old Chariton man, was arrested and transported to the Story County Jail for Theft, Driving While License Suspended, and Reckless Driving.

Huxley Officers had eleven arrests for the month. Three were for Driving Under Suspension, two were for theft, one was for Reckless Driving, one was for Public Intoxication, one for Disorderly Conduct, one for Obstruction of Emergency Communications, one for harassment, and one arrest warrant was served. Officers issued fourteen citations for the month and gave seventy three warnings. Officers received ninety four calls for service and had a total of 302 contacts for the month. Officers used 248.5 hours toward investigations or answering calls for service and gave 434.5 hours of general patrol.
