July 3rd, 2019 7:30 AM Officer was asked to check the welfare of a male resident at the 100 block of Water St. Contact was made and the resident was not in need of assistance.

July 7th, 2019 7:00 PM Officer received an assault complaint at the 200 block of Water St. The investigation is ongoing.

July 8th, 2019 11:58 PM Officer stopped a vehicle for a traffic violation in front of East Elementary. The driver of the vehicle, a 23-year-old Huxley man, was suspended from driving. He was cited and released with a court date for Driving Under Suspension.

July 9th, 2019 1:03 AM Officers responded to a Structure fire at the 100 block of 6th St. Two homes were damaged. No injuries.

July 9th, 2019 1:39 AM Officers responded to a suspicious person / trespass complaint at the 100 block of 5th St. Officer located a Nevada woman hiding on the property. She was arrested for trespass and transported to the Story County Jail. A 48-year-old Nevada man fled the scene and was later arrested for Trespass and Violation of a No contact order after a warrant was requested.

July 23rd, 2019 9:00 PM Officer received a theft complaint at the Methodist Church. Several cans that were stored in a trailer that were used to raise funds had been taken the night prior. Investigation is ongoing.

Huxley Officers had four arrests for the month. Two were for trespass, one was for violation of a no contact order, and one for Driving Under Suspension. Huxley Officers received sixteen calls for the month and had a total of seventy-five contacts. Officers used 20.5 hours toward investigations and provided 99 hours of general patrol.
