Huxley Police Department
Report for July 2019

July 2nd, 2019 12:45 AM Officer responded to a domestic altercation at the 500 block of East 4th St. The altercation was verbal, and the male half elected to stay elsewhere for the rest of the night.

July 4th, 2019 5:50 PM Officer was asked to check the welfare of a female citizen at the 500 block of East 1st St. Contact was made with the female who was transported to the hospital.

July 4th, 2019 6:10 PM Officer responded to a burglary complaint at the 200 block of Campus Dr. A camper that was in storage had been broken into and was now missing a small television valued at \$125.00.

July 5th, 2019 11:45 AM Officer responded to an ID theft complaint at the 500 block of East 1st St. The reporting party believed that her social security number had been potentially stolen earlier in the week.

July 5th, 2019 7:57 PM Officer stopped a vehicle that was involved in a burglary in Slater on Highway 210.
