Monthly Report for August 2019

August 1st, 2019 3:32 AM Officer responded to a theft complaint at the Methodist Church on 2nd Street. Several recyclable cans were taken from the trailer in the parking lot. The suspect vehicle was located south of town. A 29-year-old Newton man was charged with theft 5th, Driving While License Suspended, and other traffic citations.

August 3rd, 2019 1:46 AM Officer attempted to stop a vehicle for a traffic violation on 4th Street near Race. The vehicle, which was operated by a 31-year-old Webster City man, sped away from the officer attempting to make the stop. The vehicle was eventually located in Story County. The driver was transported to Story county Jail with several charges.

August 14th, 2019 8:36 PM Officer served an arrest warrant at the 800 block of Race Street. A Cambridge man was transported to the Story County Jail in Nevada.

August 31st, 2019 2:46 PM Officer responded to a two-vehicle accident at the Cambridge Post Office. A vehicle operated by a Cambridge man was backing out of a spot and struck another vehicle operated by a Cambridge man causing approximately \$5000 in damage. No injuries.

Huxley Officers had two arrests for the month for Theft 5th and Driving While License Suspended. Officers also served one arrest warrant. Officers issued six citations for traffic offenses and gave six warnings. Officers received eight calls for service or information and had a total of forty-seven contacts for the month. Officers used fourteen hours toward investigations or responding to calls for service and provided ninety-nine hours of general patrol.
