Monthly Report for August 2019

August 1st, 2019 8:00 AM Officer received a theft complaint at the 500 block of E 4th Street. A citizen believes that his mail has been stolen, not delivered, or delivered to the wrong address. Investigation ongoing.

August 1st, 2019 8:30 AM Officer responded to a report of a vehicle that backed into a no parking sign. Contact was made with the driver who agreed to pay for the repair of the sign post.

August 1st, 2019 1:45 PM Officer responded to a two vehicle accident at a business at the 900 block of Highway 69. A vehicle pulling out of a parking spot struck a passing vehicle passenger side causing minimal damage.

August 4th, 2019 3:00 PM Officer cited a Huxley juvenile for Possession of tobacco in Berhow Park.

August 5th, 2019 6:45 PM Officer responded to the 100 block of National Drive for a report of several juveniles who were throwing rocks at other kids in Centennial Park earlier in the day. All parties were spoken too, and parents decided to handle the situation and not pursue charges.

August 5th, 2019 9:50 PM Officer responded to a domestic altercation at the 100 block of South 3rd. The altercation was verbal, and the female half elected to stay with her parents in another residence for the remainder of the night.

August 6th, 2019 5:29 PM Officer responded to a two vehicle accident on Highway 69 near the Ballard Plaza. A vehicle operated by an Ogden woman was rear ended by a Huxley man causing approximately \$500 in damage. No injuries.

The two were confronted by management and advised they were part of a security team. After learning that these two did not belong in the building, the two were unable to be located.
