**January 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2020 4:34 PM**

A vehicle was stopped for a traffic violation on Timberlane near Centennial Drive. The driver of the vehicle, a 39-year-old Des Moines man, was Barred from driving. He was charged with Driving While Barred and taken to the Story County Jail in Nevada.

**January 7<sup>th</sup>, 2020 5:15 AM**

Received a noise complaint at the 200 block of Oak Blvd. A tenant in an apartment complex had complained of habitual noise and barking of dogs. He had complained to the landlord of the issue to no resolve. Contact was attempted with the problem tenant who refused to answer the door.
